1. Overview of the two conferences

Bonn Climate Change Conference

- 30 April to 10 May 2018 in Bonn
- SBI 48, SBSTA 48 and APA 1-5
- Many other meetings and side events



Bangkok Climate Change Conference

- 4 to 9 September 2018 in Bangkok, Thailand
- SBI 48-2, SBSTA 48-2 and APA 1-6
- Focusing on Paris Agreement Work Programme



2. Relevant outcomes on technology

A. Independent review of the effective implementation of the CTCN

Bonn Climate Change Conference in May 2018

- SBI considered the findings and recommendations of the independent review of the effective implementation of the CTCN, and the management response from the UNEP.
- SBI recommended a **draft decision** for consideration and adoption at COP 24, which contained invitations for:
 - Parties, NDEs and UNEP, in collaboration with UNIDO and CTCN AB, to implement the relevant recommendations of the independent review
 - Operating entities of the FM to consider implementing the relevant recommendations of the independent review
 - Parties and CTCN to enhance the provision of support for strengthening the capacity of NDEs, as appropriate



2. Relevant outcomes on technology

B. Periodic assessment of the Technology Mechanism

Bonn Climate Change Conference in May 2018

- SBI continued its elaboration of the scope of and modalities for the periodic assessment of the effectiveness of the TM and adequacy of the support provided to the TM in supporting the implementation of PA.
- SBI agreed to continue the discussion at Bangkok session taking into account the **informal note prepared by the Co-facilitators** on the basis of the Parties' deliberations and submitted views.

Bangkok Climate Change Conference in September 2018

- SBI issued a draft text as an outcome of the Bangkok session, which contains a **draft decision** and **draft of the scope of and modalities for the periodic assessment**.
- Presiding officers of APA, SBI and SBSTA will prepare a **joint reflections note** addressing progress made to date and identifying ways forward, including textual proposals that would be helpful for advancing Parties' deliberations by mid-October.



2. Relevant outcomes on technology

C. Technology framework

Bonn Climate Change Conference in May 2018

- SBSTA continued its elaboration of the technology framework established under the Paris Agreement, based on the initial draft of the technology framework prepared by the SBSTA Chair.
- SBSTA agreed to continue the elaboration at Bangkok session, using the **updated draft of the technology framework**, which was issued to capture the Parties' deliberations at this session.

Bangkok Climate Change Conference in September 2018

- SBSTA issued a draft text as an outcome of the Bangkok session, which contains **elements of a draft decision** and **updated draft of the technology framework**.
- Presiding officers of APA, SBI and SBSTA will prepare a **joint reflections note** addressing progress made to date and identifying ways forward, including textual proposals that would be helpful for advancing Parties' deliberations by mid-October.
