Request to expand the mandate for revising “TOOL06: Project emissions from flaring”

Procedural background

- At EB85, the Board requested the MP to recommend a revision to the “TOOL06: Project emissions from flaring” to include non-binding best practice examples.
- At MP75, the MP considered the draft revision and agreed to request the Board to expand the mandate for further revising the methodological tool.



Purpose

To expand and streamline the applicability of the methodological tool “Project emissions from flaring”.



Key issues and proposed solutions

At MP75, while working on the inclusion of non-binding best-practice examples, the MP identified elements in TOOL06 that would benefit from revision and seeks a mandate to further revise the tool to:

- a) Expand the eligibility criteria to natural gas;
- b) Update and align with the revised TOOL08 "Tool to determine the mass flow of a greenhouse gas in a gaseous stream";
- c) Better describe options B.1 and B.2 for the measurement of the flare efficiency in TOOL06;
- d) Develop a spreadsheet/tool similar to the one developed for TOOL08.



Impacts

The revision of the methodological tool “Project emissions from flaring” would provide more clarity, and expand and streamline its applicability.



Subsequent work and timelines

The MP would begin work on the revision of TOOL06 at its next meeting (MP76) and will provide a revised draft to be considered by the Board at a future meeting.



Recommendations to the Board

The MP requests the Board to expand the mandate provided at EB85 in order to further revise the methodological tool “Project emissions from flaring”.
