1. Mandate

2014. SBI invited TEC to evaluate the Poznan strategic programme with aim of enhancing effectiveness of Technology Mechanism

2015. TEC evaluated the Poznan strategic programme and submitted final report to SBI. TEC noted that projects were in early stages of implementation and therefore difficult to measure impact

2015. SBI thus invited TEC to update evaluation report and submit to SBI in Nov 2017.

Invited TEC to undertake update drawing on mid-term evaluation reports of:

- Climate technology transfer and finance centres
- GEF-4 pilot projects

2016. SBI noted it looked forward to TEC updated evaluation report

2017. SBI invited the TEC to submit the evaluation report as part of its annual report to the COP for consideration by SBI in Dec 2018



2. TEC work in 2017/2018

At its 14th meeting, the TEC:

- Considered terms of reference for updating its evaluation report (see TEC/2017/14/8)
- Noted that GEF 2016 report contained links to three mid-term evaluation reports of GEF Poznan projects
- Decided to wait until GEF submitted its 2017 report to COP, to have access to more mid-term reports for updating its evaluation

At its 15th meeting, the TEC:

- Agreed to wait for further mid-term reports to be made available as part of the GEF 2018 report, with a view to completing its updated report following the reception of the GEF 2018 report
- Decided to inform SBI 47 on its progress in updating the PSP evaluation



3. Status of projects

GEF 2018 report is now available.
